

# QLD Children's Hospital – Quick Reference Guide Academic and Research Facility Level 5 Seminar Room

#### Overview

This guide provides basic instructions for the audio visual system. The system features two 90" LCD screens and video conferencing. The user can hold presentations from a connected laptop computer.

## Start Up and Shutdown Procedures

The AV system is controlled with the AMX touch screen panel.

To begin, simply touch the screen.

To shutdown the AV system, press the **System Off** icon.

#### Volume

Use the **Volume** icons to adjust the volume level.

Press the **mute** icon to turn off the sound.

Press the Mic Controls icon to adjust the lectern and wireless microphone volume.

#### Setup

The **Setup** icon allows the user to control the system clock, volume, the LCD displays and setup the automatic shutdown feature.

### **Laptop Presentation**

- 1. Connect a laptop to the wall plate using the provided VGA and 3.5mm stereo audio cables or HDMI cable.
- 2. Turn on the laptop.
- 3. Configure the laptop to direct the video image to an external video display. Consult the laptop's help files for more information.
- 4. Press the **Presentation** tab.
- 5. Select the **Laptop** icon.
- 6. Press the None / Blank icon to blank the display screens.
- 7. Shutdown the laptop and disconnect it from the input.



# **Video Conferencing**

- 1. Press the Video Conference tab.
- 2. Select the **Dialling** icon and enter a contact number.
  - a. Press the green Call icon to connect the call.
  - b. Use the **Privacy** icon to disable outgoing audio.
  - c. Use the Far End Volume controls to adjust the incoming volume level.
  - d. Press the **PIP Layout** icon to display picture-in-picture image and move the image around the screen.
  - e. Press the Self View icon to display the near-end camera image.
- 3. Select the Send Content icon.
  - a. Press the **Send Laptop** icon to send the presentation.
  - b. Press the **Stop Sending** icon to stop sending the presentation.
- 4. Select the Camera icon.
  - a. Use the ▲▼◀▶ and **Zoom** icons to position the camera.
  - b. Use the **Preset** icons to set the camera to a predetermined position.
- 5. Select the **Far End** icon to control the far-end camera (if allowed by far end).
- 6. Press the red End icon to disconnect the call.
