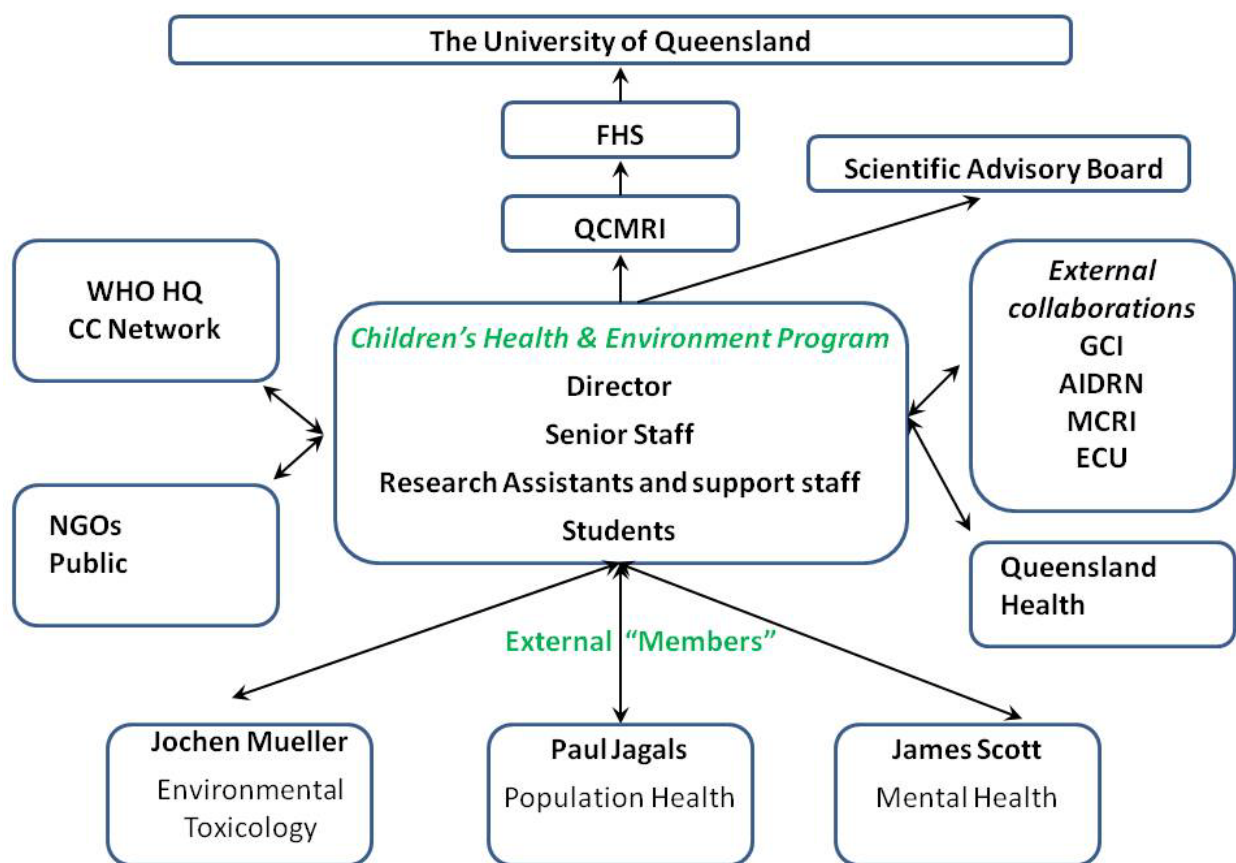


Children's Health and Environment Program Organizational Structure
