

CHEP - Terms of Reference

The WHO developed a Global Plan of Action for Children's Health and the Environment (2010-2015) through a series of meetings and consultations. This Plan of Action is used as a template to co-ordinate activities in Children's Environmental Health to maximize collaboration between groups active in this area. The Plan of Action contains five strategic areas for action:

- Strategic Area 1: Data Collection and Analysis
- Strategic Area 2: Collaborative Research
- Strategic Area 3: Advocacy
- Strategic Area 4: Clinical Capacity Building to Increase Service Delivery
- Strategic Area 5: Awareness Raising and Education.

The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the proposed Collaborating Centre for Children's Health and the Environment have been designed to address 2 of these strategic areas.

TOR 1: To assist WHO address Strategic Area 2 of the Global Action Plan on Children's Environmental Health by strengthening international and intersectoral collaborative research on children's environmental health.

TOR 2: To assist WHO address Strategic Area 5 of the Global Action Plan on Children's Environmental Health to educate and raise awareness about prevention of environmental exposures and environmentally-related diseases in children.
